### New features

- Updated video integration:
  - Now supports 3<sup>rd</sup> party video integration (see video plug-in datasheets for details)
  - Drag and drop cameras into grid layouts
  - Save and recall custom grid layouts
  - Load multiple grid layouts
  - Full screen mode for grid layouts
  - Select low bandwidth video streams (if supported by plugin)
  - Export video clips and save video snapshots
  - Automated camera import
- Windows 8.1 support for the Forcefield client.
- Support for Challenger10 V10-03 firmware features:
  - Area search
  - Challenger panel time zone
  - Automated input test
  - User start and end date now downloaded to panel
  - Variable end of line resistor option for main panel
  - New communication path options

Other enhancements:

- Updated offline history reports to allow for delayed dialler panel events being reported. This feature applies when reporting across multiple archive volumes.
- Added advanced alarm filtering into alarm monitor.

## Resolved issues

- Free format date/time entry can no longer go to U.S. format
- Challenger V8 to Challenger10 migration now properly handles door controller hardware options
- Computer category event options now always remain consistent when navigating between events
- Challenger V8 account code no longer changes when the first area account code changes
- Fixed issues with auto generated alarm group report
- Fixed door/list activity report when using CSV format and reporting to disk
- Added templates to User Floor Access report
- Can now run all reports from non-server nodes
- Fixed lock when saving report template
- Added alternate profile information into Users by Profile report
- Offline history now works with 60 character user names
- Renaming timezones no longer clears timezone programming
- Server failover configuration is now retained after Forcefield upgrade
- Intercom video data is no longer corrupted when upgrading from 6.4 to 7.x
- User Access report now shows name and number for all users
- Challenger Report is no longer displayed in multi-line format when selecting single-line format
- Challenger reports now show inputs above 512
- Client now gets mirror IP address from mirroring configuration, not node 8 or 40 IP address
- Challenger times are no longer out by time zone offset when Challenger events option is ticked in History reports
- Timed option for door/floor/alarm groups now works consistently
